

**SOCORRO COUNTY  
BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
RESOLUTION 2009-17**

**ROAD REVIEW COMMITTEE**

**Whereas**, the Board of County Commissioners of Socorro County, met in a special re-organizational meeting on January 5, 2009, at 10:00 A.M. in the Socorro County Annex Building, 198 Neel Ave., Socorro, New Mexico 87801; and,

**Whereas**, the County Commissioners of Socorro County shall appoint a minimum of three (3) individuals, but not more than twelve (12) to a board of commissioners, hereby, known as "Road Review Committee"; and,

**Whereas**, State Statute 67-5-4 (Discontinuance; procedure; viewers; county-line roads); requires that any road or part of the road then established and maintained as a public highway is not needed, or the repairs of the same are burdensome and in excess of the benefits therefrom, they may at a regular meeting appoint a board of commissioners (Road Review) of three freeholders of the county as road viewers, to view such road or part of the road, and make a report (in writing) thereof to the Board of County Commissioners at their next regular meeting, setting forth fully their finding, and if they recommend a discontinuance of such road or part of a road, then the Board of County Commissioners may order the same vacated: provided, that if such road runs on the county line between two counties, the County Commissioners of both the counties interested shall appoint viewers and the concurrence of the County Commissioners of both counties shall be necessary to vacate it."

**Whereas**, each location being viewed shall be conducted by a panel of not less than three of the appointed twelve (12) member committee; and,

**Whereas**, the Board of County Commissioners shall assign the Road Superintendent and/or Assistant Road Superintendent to assist the panel in locating said property and to determine if any residents will be land locked; and

**Whereas**, the Road Superintendent and/or Assistant Supervisor not serve to make recommendations to the panel, unless it would be detrimental to the adjacent land-owners (access to land); and,

**Whereas**, if at least two of the three appointed viewers agree that the road is not needed or is too expensive, they must submit their recommendation, in writing, to the County Commission at he next regularly scheduled meeting for action.


