PARTICIPATION IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT ROAD FUND PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY
THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the County of Socorro and the New Mexico Department of Transportation have entered into a joint and coordinated effort; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of this project will be **\$122,001.00** to be funded in proportional. Share by the parties hereto as follows:

- a. New Mexico Department of Transportation share shall be 75% or **\$91,501.00**
and
- b. Socorro County's proportional matching share shall be 25% or **\$30,500.00**

TOTAL PROJECT COST IS \$122,001.00

Socorro County shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of \$122,001.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED in official session that Socorro County determines, resolves, and orders as follows:

The project for this Cooperative agreement is adopted and has a priority standing.

The agreement terminates on December 31, 2010 and the County of Socorro incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into the written agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the County of Socorro to enter into Cooperative Agreement Project Number SP-1-10(904), Control number HW2 M100127 with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for LGRF project for year 2009/2010 to Design, chip seal and stripe-Montoya Road (Magdalena Area)-Take US 60 west to Magdalena, go south on Kelly Road 1 mile east .3 miles to job site, and Install (4) 14' steel frame cattle guards-CR-127 La Mesa Redonda Road-Go east on US 60 approximately 21 miles , turn south on CR- 127, go 5 miles to #2 cattle guard, go ½ mile to #3 cattle guard, go south 1 mile to #4 cattle guard and Install (1) 21' steel framed cattle guard- CR-125 Red Canyon Road- East of CR-127 go approx 2-1/2 miles to #5 cattle guard. If needed Socorro County will be responsible for Environment/Archaeological study, within the control of the County of Socorro in Socorro New Mexico.
