Resolution No. 2011-34

Emergency/Disaster Declaration

WHEREAS, the County of Socorro has suffered damage caused by a Severe Winter Storm and extreme Cold Weather during the period from the 1st day of February, 2011 and the 4th day of February, 2011 and continuing Severe Winter Weather expected to impact the County through February, 2011; and,

WHEREAS, extensive damage was caused to public property, roads, public utilities, water associations and to private property; and,


WHEREAS, The damage has resulted in undue human suffering and hardship and threatens the safety, health, welfare, and well-being of citizens and economic function of the County of Socorro; and,

WHEREAS, all locally available public and private resources and forces available to mitigate and alleviate the damage are deemed insufficient to cope with the resulting situation, initiate repairs, and meet restoration requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, by virtue of the authority provided by the New Mexico Civil Emergency Preparedness Act (NMSA 1978, 12-10-01 to 12-10-11) do hereby declare the County of Socorro to be an emergency/disaster area for the purpose of exercising necessary emergency powers and expenditure of available resources, and requesting aid, assistance, and relief programs, and funds available from the State of New Mexico.
