RESOLUTION 2011-62

ADOPTING THE SOCORRO COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL  
HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners met in a regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, August 9, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. in the Socorro County Annex Building 198 Neel Ave., Socorro, New Mexico 87801; and,

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to NMSA 1978 Section 4-38-1 (1884) the powers of a county as a body politic and corporate shall be exercised by a board of county commissioners; and,

**WHEREAS**, NMSA 1978, Sections 4-37-1 *et seq.* provides that counties may adopt those resolutions and ordinances, not inconsistent with statutory or constitutional limitations placed on counties, to discharge those powers necessary and proper to provide for the safety, preserve the health, promote the prosperity and improve the morals, order, comfort and convenience of the county and its inhabitants; and,

**WHEREAS**, the County of Socorro recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

**WHEREAS**, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

**WHEREAS**, an adopted Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Socorro fully participated in the FEMA prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare this Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the New Mexico Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VI officials have reviewed the "*Socorro*

County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan” July 2011 and approved it July 20, 2011 contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governing body;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Socorro adopts the “*Socorro County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan*” as an official plan dated July 2011; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Board of County Commissioners of Socorro County will submit this Adoption Resolution to the New Mexico Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VI officials to enable the Plan’s final approval.


